**A Free Ear Screening Camp** was successfully organized by the **Rotary Club of Central Banke** in collaboration with **Bageshwari Secondary School, Gavar, Baijanath**. The technical support for the camp was provided by **BN Community Ear Care Hospital, Banke, Nepalgunj**. The event was held on **7th November 2025** at **Bageshwari Secondary School, Gavar**.

## Objective of the Camp

The main objective of the Free Ear Screening Camp was to:

- Promote **awareness on ear health and hygiene** in the community,
- Provide **free ear check-up and treatment services**,
- Identify **ear-related problems such as infections, wax, hearing loss, and other conditions**, and
- **Refer patients** requiring advanced medical intervention for further treatment.

## **Program Summary**

The camp received an encouraging response from the local community, with about **290 people directly benefiting** from the services provided by the medical team. During the camp:

- **39** cases of **ear wax** were removed
- **7** cases of **otomycosis** (fungal ear infection) were treated
- **13** cases of **Chronic Otitis Media (COM)** were identified
- **10** individuals were found to have **hearing loss**
- **5** cases of **foreign body removal** were successfully managed
- **9** individuals were advised and referred for **ear operations**
